

Adobe Dreamweaver - Basic (1 day)

Course Aim

This comprehensive course introduces users to the leading industry standard web design tool, Adobe Dreamweaver.

Participants will plan and define a Web site, work with text and graphic files.

Participants will learn about the importance of creating and using CSS style sheets, they'll apply styles to text, and create class styles and pseudo-element styles.

Choose appropriate image formats, insert images, modify image properties, insert and modify background images, and write effective alternate text.

Create links to other pages and resources, create named anchors and link to them, create e-mail links, create an image map, and apply CSS styles to link states.

By the end of the course participants will have a good overview of the available tools Adobe Dreamweaver in order to create HTML pages.

Course Prerequisites

Previous experience using applications on a PC or Macintosh is an essential prerequisite for this course.

Users should be familiar with using a keyboard and mouse.
